

Explore & Inspire

Curriculum Overview:

This term our focus text is 'At the beach' by Roland Harvey. The story describes a family on holiday, and the children write postcards home to grannie. We will be introducing Lola our class teddy bear who will be coming home with the children for weekends, and the children are encouraged to write a post card to their friends to tell them what they have been doing. All of our work will link to holidays, beaches, and hopefully there will be lots of ice cream and waffles!

In science we will be doing lots of work on forces, and space. We will learn about the phases of the moon, and the different shapes. In history we will be learning about Amy Johnson- a significant person from the past. Amy Johnson was born here in Hull and was the first woman to fly solo to Australia! In the second half term we will be learning about the great fire of London – did you know it started in a bakery? We will be researching the different continents, and making comparisons between them.

In maths we will continue to develop our understanding of number, addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers and will introduce fractions. Later in the term we will revisit time and money.
