Explore & Inspire

Curriculum Overview:

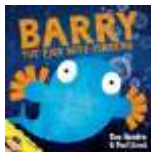
This term our topic is Amazing Humans. Our focus texts are 'Barry the Fish with Fingers' 'Supertato' and 'I Need a Wee'.

We will be focussing on each book for 4 weeks and all our classroom activities will link to the books.

Enrich and Explore

Core Book(s):

Barry the Fish with Fingers



- Visit the deep, can you find any fish with fingers? What colour fish can you see? Can you find a big fish and a little fish?
- What do your fingers feel? Do a hunt to find objects with different textures, can you find something soft? Something rough, spiky, fluffy? You could make your own feely book.
- Can you blow bubbles like puffy the puffer fish?
- Water play with bubbles and whisks – how many bubbles can you make? You could add food colouring to the water to enhance this activity.
- Create a treasure box like the one in the story. What will you put in yours? Shiny things? A blue collection? Ticky things?



Supertato



- What vegetables do you like to eat, try a new taste this week
- Visit the supermarket, which vegetables can you find?
- Make and taste vegetable soup.

For personalised targets please refer to your child's Personalised Plan.

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- Grow some vegetables – carrots and radish are very easy and quick to grow.
- Use a water tray and soapy water to wash some vegetables like Supertato in the story
- Use a potato masher to squash different things, playdough, a banana, peas.
- Explore jelly using your different senses, how does it smell? Taste? Feel?



I Need a Wee



- Play with balloons, can you make big ones? Little ones? Are there different shaped balloons? Can you find one like Alan's balloon?
- Put on some music and dance, can you dance like Alan?
- Look at photographs of fair rides – have you ever been on a big wheel? Or other rides?
- You could bake a cake; which type is your favourite? My favourite is carrot cake.
- You could try on different hats and send the pictures to me on class dojo– do you have a magician's hat?
