Curriculum Overview:

This term we are focusing on 'Being Healthy.' We are going to look at how we can keep our bodies healthy physically and mentally by exploring the eating well plate and spending time outside. We are researching Florence Nightingale and how she changed hygiene in hospitals. In D+T we will be investigating how kites work and building our own kite from researched materials. Enrich

Core Book(s): Blitz Bus or Puffin Keeper

Activity Ideas:

English:

Re-tell a story in your own words.

Practise reading words and sentences in different voices including loud, quiet, angry, surprised, happy and sad

Maths:

Add and subtract different objects around your house.

Practise giving directions to somebody using forwards, backwards, right, left.

Place objects in, on, under, between other objects in your home

Go through your day with an adult what will you be doing in order. Can you remember what you will do next?

Use a clock to tell the time to o'clock and half past

Science:

Have a look at pictures of yourself and your family as a baby and now. What are the differences? What did you need as a baby that has changed to now.

Think about what you need to have everyday and how important it is.

PSHE:

Talk about how you would be a good friend

If you go out in the community think about how you would greet a person you don't know e.g., at the hospital/ shop.

History & Geography:

Research different places and look at how they are different or similar to here

If you go out in the community what landmarks can you see?

Pretend to be Florence Nightingale in a hospital. How would you make somebody feel better?
