Core Books:









In our English sessions we will be exploring the stories of Roald Dahl (or for some Julia Donaldson) with a particular focus on The Enormous Crocodile and George's Marvellous Medicine. We will be working on writing sentences to describe what has happened and some of the characters. We will practice our comprehension skills by answering questions on our core books. We will be sharing our likes and dislikes of the different stories we explore.

As Mathematicians we will be investigating numbers focusing on addition, subtraction and number bonds; exploring 2D and 3D shapes; learning more about money; and describing positions using positional language (above, below, on top, etc.).



As Scientists, we will be learning all about different animals. Exploring their habitats and their offspring.

In Geography, we will be comparing the coast and countryside exploring the differences and similarities between the two. Hopefully with a trip to at least the coast or the countryside.





As Historians, we will be investigating 'The Lady of the Lamp' Florence Nightingale and the differences between modern hospitals and Victorian hospitals.

In Computing, we will be learning all about E-Safety and exploring ways to keep ourselves safe online.



We will be looking at the natural sculptures of Andy Goldsworthy to inspire our own natural sculptures in Art session. We will then use the zoom function on the iPad to take photos of different parts of our work. We will also be using clay to create objects.

In Design and Technology this term we will be designing and creating our own cushion covers.





As Musicians, we will be exploring classical music and orchestras. We will be learning what instruments are part of an orchestra and will be exploring different genres of music and expressing how music makes us feel.

We will be continuing with our sessions with Hull KR during the summer term with a focus on Athletics using our bodies to move in different ways. Those that don't access the Hydro pool in school will be having swimming sessions at Albert Avenue Pool.

In our PSHE sessions, we will be working on the topics of relationships and changing me. We will continue to develop our social skills and how to make and maintain friendships and learn about our body parts.





We will be continuing to learn about different religions and celebrations during our Religion and World View sessions focusing on Christians and Muslims. We will be learning about the tale of Moses.

Activity Ideas:

English


Our core books are: George's Marvelous Medicine, Fantastic Mr Fox, The Enormous Crocodile and The Giraffe, the Pelly and Me

- Listen to our core books on Youtube
- Visit the library and borrow some books to enjoy together and ask your child questions about the stories
- Act out parts of stories
- Draw a story map together of your child's favourite story

Maths

- Go on a shape hunt
- Write a shopping list and go to the shops exploring different prices in the shops and have your child help you make the total using different coins
- Play a positional game with one of your child's toys and a box (put the teddy in the box or put the doll behind the box)
- Use things around your house to create addition and subtraction number sentences











Geography

• Take a trip to the seaside and explore the natural and manmade features

Computing

- Play games together on a tablet/computer
- Discuss how they can keep safe when using the internet

Religion and World Views

- Listen to the story of Moses on YouTube which will be explored in class
- Celebrate different celebrations as a family

PSHE

- Play games together practising taking turn skills

- Listen to different music together and talk about what you like and dislike about the piece and how it makes you feel
