Topic: Amazing Humans

Explore & Inspire

Curriculum Overview:

This term our theme is 'Amazing Humans' and we will be using a variety of subjects to look at how amazing our bodies are!

In English we will be looking at significant authors and a range of books they have written. The author we will focus on is Julia Donaldson. We will be reading and listening to her stories and deciding which ones are our favourites and what we like and dislike about them. We will be practising our fine motor skills and where we can be working on our letter formation and writing words.

As Mathematician we will continue to investigate number and work out what adding and taking away means. As well as working on number we will be looking at shape, measure and exploring change. Our maths learning will continue into our continuous provision.

As Scientists, we will be learning the correct names for our body parts and what our senses do. This will link to some of our PSHE lessons on how our body changes as we grow. Our PSHE themes are 'Changing Me' and 'Relationships'.

As Historians, we will be looking at 'Medicine', as part of this we will be able to identify who helps us to stay healthy such as doctors, nurses and dentists. Linking to PSHE we will also identify who is a 'safe adult' and who we can go to if we are worried. This also has links to computing where there is a focus on knowing how to keep safe when using IT devices.

In Computing, we will know how to use a device and find a game that we like to play, we will also be using the iPad to take photographs of activities that we complete.

As Geographers, we will be looking at the difference between the coast and the countryside and hopefully will be able to go on a trip to a farm and the beach. We will be looking at places that we visit and try to identify different places using google maps.

As Designers we will have a focus on fabric, we will explore what fabrics are used for different reasons and make our own piece of work using fabric.

In Religion and World View we will continue to look at celebrations throughout the term with a focus on Eid al-Fitr. We will also be reading some stories in the Bible and the Qu'ran.

As Artists, we will be working with materials to make a sculpture and collages, with a focus on the work by Frida Kahlo.

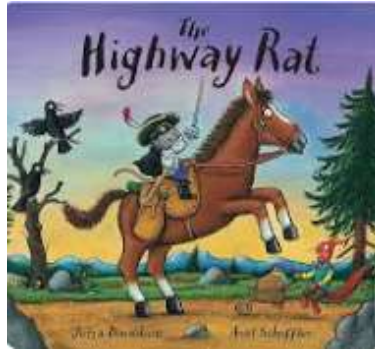

Activity Ideas:

Go to the library and see if you can find any other Julia Donaldson books. Do you have any of her books at home? Which is your favourite? Why don't you bring a book into school to share with the rest of the class?





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Plant some seeds in the garden and watch them grow, maybe plant a sunflower and measure it as it gets taller and taller.

If you go for a health appointment ask if you can take a picture of the person who you see so that you can bring it into school and we can talk about who helps us.

Go and visit different places in Hull, are there any buildings that you recognise. Do you know where these places are and what they are called?

If you go to the coast or countryside have a good look around and see how it is different to where you live? What can you see? What are these called?

Did you see any horses, cows or sheep? How many did you see?

If you go to the seaside can you see any seagulls, amusements, fish and chips, ice cream, sand, sea or shells?

Listen to different types of music such as classical, jazz, pop and any other music you can think of. Which do you like best? How does it make you feel?

Practice counting whenever you can! How many scoops of sand does it take to fill a bucket up? What numbers are on your door at home? Can you see any numbers when you go to the shops?

Can you practice saying the sounds that different letters make? Can you see any letters when you go outside? Do the letters make any words?

Have a look at some art work by Frida Kahol. Can you make your own collage faces using things that you can find at home or in the garden? Take a photograph and bring it into school to show everyone.
